

MOBILE SOLAR POWER FUELS LOW ALTITUDE AERIAL PHOTOGRAPHY AT UPCOMING NASCAR EVENT IN PHOENIX

~Two Phoenix-based Businesses Partner in Demonstration of Cutting Edge Technologies, at P.I.R. ~

Phoenix, AZ – October 27, 2008 – Spirit of the Sun Solar Systems (S.O.S.), LLC and High Res Media, LLC announce today, they will show how sun collected several months ago by an S.O.S. Solar Generator, supplies all the power necessary (and then some) to capture low altitude, high resolution images of the upcoming NASCAR race and its environs. The event is scheduled for November 9 at Phoenix International Raceway and will take place in the parking lot on the final day (Sunday) of the races. The images captured will not be available for resale but will be displayed to demonstrate the S.O.S. solar generator and High Res Media capabilities. Principals from both companies will be available to answer questions and distribute additional information.

Dan Jones, president of S.O.S. Solar Systems became interested initially in solar generators to power his hunting camps in Up-State, New York – an activity enjoyed by many, nationwide. Soon after, he realized there were many other applications for solar generators. While visiting his sister in Arizona, he quickly saw for himself, what a perfect setting sunny Arizona is for mobile generators and solar energy in general. Now, he runs all his power carpentry equipment including but not limited to, fans, lights and small refrigerator from the solar unit that he has constructed, provides. Jones, an understated, brilliant inventor/entrepreneur says, “The possibilities for the mobile, solar generator are vast. As long as there are places that don’t have an available source of power, there are places that need solar generators. Even if grid power is available, a mobile solar generator is great for back up should there be a power outage.”

Anthony Benton, co-owner of High Res Media says, “This is exactly what we have been looking for. Then, you add the intense flood lights we use outside the home. The S.O.S. solar generator powers all the High Res Media spot-lights and this saves each homeowner, considerable money. The S.O.S. Solar Generator saves High Res Media, around \$500 per week in gas to power conventional, gas generators!”

The two companies – neighboring garage, start-ups in Ahwatukee - will be jointly exhibiting their respective capabilities/technologies to the public from 9 am to 5 pm at Phoenix International Raceway parking lot, Sunday, November 9. High Res Media has a 75 foot pole with a camera and telephoto lens mounted on it, feeding computer equipment located in its, “tricked out”, state-of-the art van. High Res Media, will be capturing race track and other images at the NASCAR event and the S.O.S solar generator will supply all necessary power for the operation.
